Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, Oscar F. Baker, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of ONE DOLLARS, and other valuable considerations to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has (have) granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Mary Belt, her heirs and assigns

All that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land lying, situate and being in Gantt Township, State and County aforesaid, on the East side of Baker Road, and known and designated as lot No. 4 of the property of Oscar F. Baker, according to survey of J. Coke Smith, Surveyor, August 1946, plat recorded in office of R.M.C., Greenville County, in Plat Book, Page 111, and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Baker Road joint front corners of lots Nos. 3 and 4, said plat, and running thence with said Baker Road N. 4-15 E. 100 feet to line of lot No. 5, said plat; thence with line of said lot No. 5 S. 76.00 E. 200 feet to iron pin; thence S. 4-15 W. 100 feet to line of lot No. 3; thence with line of lot No. 3 N. 76.00 W. 200 feet to the point of beginning.

This conveyance is made subject to the following restrictions: (1) Not to be rented or sold to persons of African descent; (2) Premises herein shall not be re-subdivided so as to face any other road; (3) No residence to be constructed on the within premises costing less than \$1750.00; (4) No surface toilets to be constructed or permitted upon the premises; (5) All residences shall be equipped with sanitary plumbing, with septic tanks approved by the County Health authorities and (6) Premises to be used exclusively for residential purposes.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

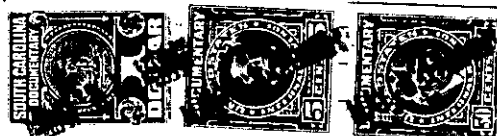
