to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Nell Gaines Jenkins

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said NELL GAINES JENKINS, her Heirs and Assigns, forever:

All those two lots of land known and designated as Lots No. 15 and 16, of Block O, of Riverside, according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book A, at page 332.

These are the same two lots of land conveyed to the grantor as Trustee by deed of L. R. Norton dated September 13, 1950, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 418, at page 491.

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TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Nell Gaines Jenkins,

her Heirs and Assigns forever.
