

POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I,

John James Parish now in the Naval Service of the United States, do hereby make, constitute, and appoint my wife, Martha Greene Parish my true and lawful attorney in fact, for me and in my name, place and stead to sell, mortgage, hypothecate, give, exchange, lease, lend, or otherwise deal with any property, real, personal, or mixed, including, but not limited to, automobiles, stocks, bonds, securities, bank accounts, and life insurance policies, in which I may have any interest whatsoever, upon such terms and conditions as he (or she) may consider fitting, and to execute any deeds or instruments in writing in connection therewith; to rent or purchase and execute any leases or agreements for the rental or purchase of any interest in any property, real, personal, or mixed; to take any action he (or she) may deem advisable for the investment, increase, care, improvement, or preservation of my money or any property in which I may have any interest whatsoever; to register and to secure all licenses and permits required or desirable for all property in which I may have any interest whatsoever, including automobiles; to receive, endorse, and collect checks, payable to me or my order, and to receive payment of any and all property, inheritances, debts, or accounts which are or may become payable to me, and to give full discharge for same; to execute vouchers in my behalf for any and all allowances and reimbursements properly payable to me by the United States, including but not restricted to allowances and reimbursements for transportation of dependents or for shipments of household effects as authorized by law and Navy Regulations, and to receive, endorse, and collect the proceeds of checks payable to the order of the undersigned drawn on the Treasurer of the United States; to initiate, conduct, or compromise any litigation or proceedings before any court, board or other tribunal in which I may have an interest as a party or otherwise, and to execute any affidavits, pleadings, or other papers incident thereto; and generally to act for me in all matters and ways which he (or she) may consider necessary or advisable to the proper conduct of my affairs; hereby giving and granting unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever, requisite, necessary and proper to be done in and about the premises, as fully, to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do, if personally present, with full power of substitution and revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney, or his (or her) substitute, shall lawfully do, or cause to be done, by virtue hereof.

For the protection, and in the interest of my said attorney, I hereby declare it to be my intention, and promise him (or her) that the authority herein granted shall not be terminated by my death but shall, to the fullest extent permitted by law, continue until such time as my death may be in fact known to him (or her) or officially announced by the U.S. Navy Department, unless otherwise revoked.

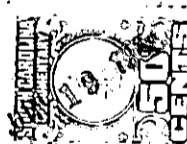
The powers herein granted shall cease and terminate upon my release from active duty in the U.S. Naval Service without notice or express revocation thereof.
