That I, J. A. Cannon, Jr. in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Thirty-three Hundred Fifty and No/100- - - - - (3350.00) DOLLARS, and assumption of mortgage set out below,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Emery C. Massingill, his Heirs and Assigns forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, at the Southeastern corner of the intersection of Dryland Drive and Barnshaw Avenue, being known and designated as Lot No. 48 on the Plat of the Souci Heights Subdivision, recorded in Plat Book Z at Page 53, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of a three-foot sidewalk running along Barnshaw Avenue, said pin being the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 47 and 48, and running thence along the eastern edge of said sidewalk, N. 35-35 W. 76.3 feet to an iron pin on the Southern edge of a three-foot sidewalk running along Dryland Drive, said pin being the front corner of Lot No. 48; thence along the Southern edge of said sidewalk, S. 65-35 E. 115.8 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of Lot No. 48; thence S. 30-10 W. 70 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 48 and 49; thence along the northern line of Lot No. 49, S. 62-12 W. 120.9 feet to an iron pin, the beginning point.

Said premises being the same conveyed to the Grantor by deed recorded in Book of Deeds 429 at Page 165.

This property is subject to restrictions contained in the Deed of Gift to the said

Grantee to pay 1951 taxes.

As a part of the consideration for the deed, the Grantor has agreed to pay \$4,000.00 on a mortgage executed by the Grantor to the First National Loan Association in the original amount of \$12,000.00, recorded in Book of Deeds 429 at Page 165.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

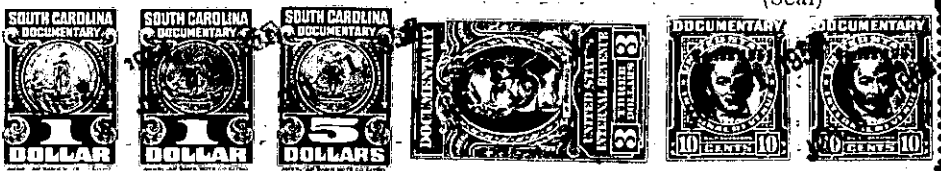
