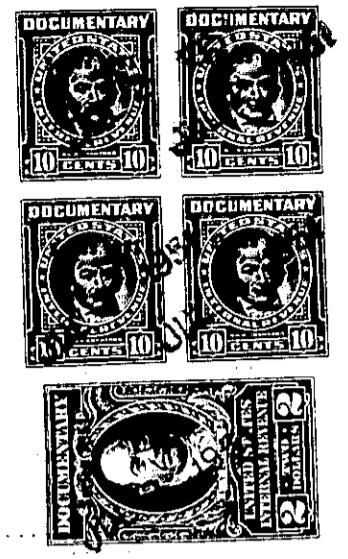

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said TOM JOE AND MELREE W. BOGGS

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in BATES Township, GREENVILLE  
County, State of South Carolina, BEGINNING on the west side of Lindberg Street, in  
the village of Slater, S. C. : and being and designated as lot No. 14 of Block  
D. as shown on plat of village of S. Slater & Sons Inc; made by J. E. Sirrene  
& Co; Engineers, on July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the office of  
R. M. C. for Greenville County, in plat book K. at page 63, 64 & 65 and  
having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds to wit;

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of Lindberg  
Street at joint front corner of lots 13 and 14 of Block D, and running thence  
with line of lot No. 13, N. 51-20 W. 110 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 38-40 E.  
70 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of lot No. 15, S. 51-2- E. 110 feet to
