in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Howard Allison, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Chick Springs Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 2, of Block C, of a subdivision known as Pinehurst, as shown on plat thereof made by W. N. Willis, Engineer, on Oct. 28, 1948 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at page 77, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Lee Road at the corner of Lot No. 1, which point is 75.3 feet northeast of the intersection of Pinehurst Drive, and running thence along the south side of Lee Road, N. 73-03 E. 75.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 25-58 E. 150 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 3; thence along the line of that lot, S. 62-23 W. 73 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 1 in the line of Lot No. 3; thence along the line of Lot No. 1, N. 26-23 W. 164.3 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described lot is one of the lots conveyed to me by J. B. Hall and R. E. Cox by deed dated November 29, 1948 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 366, at page 455.

The grantee is to pay taxes for the year 1951.
