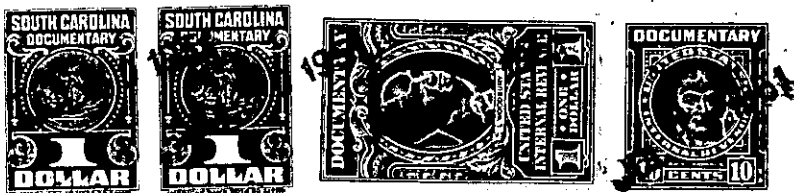

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That McCALL MANUFACTURING COMPANY

of the sum of FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR AND 30/100 Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto DONALD E. BALTZ, his heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 50 on the Plat of College Heights made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "P", page 75, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southern side of Princeton Avenue at the joint front corners of Lots 49 and 50, and running thence S33-10E 175 feet to an iron pin; thence N56-50E 75 feet to an iron pin; thence N33-10W 175 feet to an iron pin on Princeton Avenue; thence with Princeton Avenue S56-50W 75 feet to the beginning corner.

The property hereby conveyed is a portion of the property conveyed to Victory Textiles (now McCall Manufacturing Company) by deed of Modern Industries of Greenville, South Carolina, dated December 20, 1948, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 369, page 71.

This property is conveyed subject to the restrictive covenants and building restrictions applicable to College Heights, which are recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 297, page 218, and Deed Book 393, page 429.
