on or about the 26th day of June in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-one exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Mirian Haskell Page, et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 5th day of July 1951, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to T. D. Link for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. F-3100)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$5000.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said T. D. Link

All that tract, piece or parcel of land, lying, being and situate, in the County of Greenville, in South Carolina, containing 80 acres, more or less, bounded on the south by Stokes Land, on the East by Mr. Huff's land, on the west by lands of O. B. Davenport and of Dr. Jordan, said land being known as the McDavis Place. Being the same property conveyed to Alice N. Page by J. W. Page on December 14, 1914 by deed of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 26, at page 483, said deed reciting that said tract of land contained 70 acres, more or less, but upon a recent survey, it is determined, that said tract of land contains 80 acres.
