to the grantor in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Tommie Lewis Sherman, his heirs and assigns forever:-

That certain lot of land designated as lot 1-H of Block No. 1 as shown on plat of the B. S. Sherman Estate, by H. S. Brockman, September 25th, 1942, in Chick Springs Township, School District 9-H, said County and State, in the new western limits of the City of Greer, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning at the western edge of a proposed 15 foot road at the southeastern corner of said lot and running with said road N 17-48 E seventy (70) feet to corner of lot 1-I; thence as dividing line between 1-H and 1-I lots N 72-12 W sixty-eight and six-tenths (68.6) feet to iron pin on the Earle Duncan Estate line; thence with that line S 17-48 W seventy (70) feet to iron pin; thence dividing 1-G and 1-H lots S 72-12 E sixty-eight and six-tenths (68.6) feet to the beginning corner.
