Butler (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James F. Butler, his heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances:

BEGINNING on an iron pin in the center of the old Buncombe Road now the road leading from Locust Hill to Greer and running thence N. 30.15 E. 150 feet to a stake; thence S. 49.15 E. 125 feet to a stake; thence S. 28.45 W. 125 feet to a point in above said road, thence with said road N. 61.15 W. 125 feet. Containing 0.39 acres.

The above grantors are the sole heirs of George W. Poole, deceased, who died on May 15, 1915, interstate. The above described land is a portion of a twenty-two acre tract of land sold to George W.
