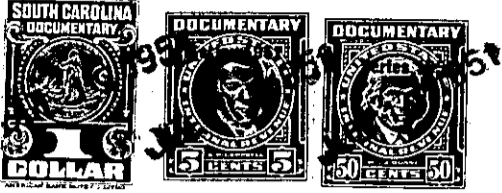

All those certain two pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the Township of Oaklawn, County and State aforesaid, and known and designated as Lots Nos. 6 and 7 on a plat of property of A. L. Meares and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for the County and State aforesaid in Plat Book "V", Page 192, said plat having been made by John C. Smith, Surveyor, October, 1949, each of said lots having a frontage on a new cut or reserved road of 70 feet and running back in parallel lines 219 feet, the courses and distances of said lots being as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the new cut or reserved road, joint corner of lots 6 and 7, 9 and 10, and running along joint line of Lot No. 7, S. 2.00 W. 219 feet to a stake in line of tract No. 1; thence S. 86.00 W. along the line parallel with new cut or reserved road 140 feet to joint corner of lots nos. 4 and 5; thence along joint line of lots nos. 4 and 5, N. 2.00 E. 219 feet to a point in center of said reserved road, joint corner of Lots Nos. 4, 5, 11 and 12; thence along center of new cut or reserved road, N. 86.00 E. 140 feet to the beginning corner.
