That I, Robert R. Bishop, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twelve Thousand and no/100 (\$12,000.00) DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jack T. Welch, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that lot of land with the improvements thereon situate on the North side of East North Street Extension (formerly known as the Old Spartanburg Road), in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown as Lot G-7, on plat of Part of Property of Overbrook Land Co., made by H. O. Jones, Engr. Sept. 1913, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "E", at pages 250 and 251, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of East North Street Extension, at joint front corner of Lots G-6 and G-7, and running thence along the line of Lot G-6, N 48-32 W 200.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N 48-33 E 35.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N 2-19 W 52.7 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot G-8, S 48-32 E 234.2 feet to an iron pin on the North side of East North Street Extension; thence along the North side of East North Street Extension, S 41-38 W 73.5 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the Grantor by deed of Overbrook Land Co., dated November 28, 1921, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 72, at page 18. Grantee to pay 1951 taxes.
