KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, Lillian D. Hartsell, Louise M. Davis (correctly known as Annie Louise Miller Davis, erroneously called in some of the estate records Louise A. Davis) and Jean M. Davis in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 Dollars (\$1.00) and the partition of real estate to the grantors in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantees, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas G. Davis, Jr. and Jean Davis Prevost

All our undivided right, title and interest in and to all those certain pieces, parcels and lots of land situate, lying and being in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

(1) All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the north side of East Court Street and extending in a northerly direction to the south side of Poole Street and being located approximately 69.6 feet east of Heldman (Davis) Street, having a frontage on East Court Street of 210 feet and a frontage on Poole Street of 204 feet, more or less, with a uniform depth of 167 feet, more or less, being known and designated as Lot No. 11, Block 2, Page 64, according to the City Block Book.

(2) All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina at the northwest corner of the intersection of Webster and Boyce Streets, having a frontage on the north side of Webster Street of 110 feet and on the west side of Boyce Street of 72.3 feet and known and designated as Lot No. 7, Block 5, Page 61, according to the City Block Book.

(3) All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, at the northwest corner of the intersection of Pack Street and Pack Alley, having a frontage on the north side of Pack Street of 152 feet, more or less, and on the west side of Pack Alley of 136 feet and known and designated as Lot No. 24, Block 9, Page 123, according to the County Block Book.
