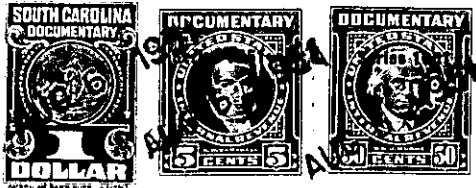

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That I, R. B. Gresham  
Of Piedmont, S. C.  
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00)  
and No/100 Dollars  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by John T. Wilson  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John T. Wilson  
his heirs and assigns, forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina containing six tenths (6/10) of one acre, more or less.

Adjoining lands of myself, Jim McCullough and possibly others, and being  
known as Lots No. 3 and 8 of the sub-division of lands formerly known as the  
W. P. Nesbitt lands near St. Matthews Church on the Pelzer-Greenville Road.

Being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point in center of  
Pelzer-Greenville Road, joint corner of Lot No. 2, property of Jim McCullough,  
and running thence with line of Lot No. 2, S. 77 1/2 W. 160' to joint corner of  
Lots 2, 3, 7, and 8; thence with line of Lot No. 7, S. 77 1/2 W. 160 feet to a  
point in center of driveway, joint corner of Lots 7, 8, 12 and 13; thence with  
line of Lot No. 13 along center of driveway S. 28-50 E. 85 feet to an iron pin;  
thence N. 77 1/2 E. 160 feet to an iron pin on corner of Lot No. 3; thence with  
line of Lot No. 3 N. 77 1/2 E. 160 feet to a point in center of Pelzer-Greenville  
Road; thence with center of said road N. 28-50 W. 85 feet to beginning corner.

The above described land is a part of W. P. Nesbitt the same conveyed to me by  
November 1945 on the 26 day of  
Greenville , deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for  
County, in Book 283 Page 238

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the  
said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said John T. Wilson  
his Heirs and Assigns forever.
