WHEREAS, because of said abandonment, lack of any intention ever to use the same, and in order to rid itself of any responsibility to open a street or roadway through said strip, Greenville County desires at this time to quitclaim to Slater Manufacturing Co., Inc., its successors or assigns, any interest which it may have in said strip; and

WHEREAS, J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc., is the successor in title to Slater Manufacturing Co., Inc., of all the lands shown upon the plat herein referred to except such property as may have heretofore been conveyed away by Slater Manufacturing Co., Inc., or its predecessors in title,

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That Greenville County, South Carolina, pursuant to a resolution of the County Board of Commissioners of Greenville County, South Carolina, dated August *10th*, 1951, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and the premises to it in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold, released and quitclaimed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, release and quitclaim unto J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc., all the right, title and interest of Greenville County, South Carolina, in and to a strip of land fifty (50) feet in width and one hundred fifty (150) feet in length lying on the Northwestern side of Talley Bridge Road between Lots 1 and 2, Block K, in the Slater Manufacturing Company Village at Slater, in Greenville County, South Carolina, as shown on a plat entitled "Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc.," made by J. E. Sirrine & Company, Engineers,
