

long as the said Henry Coleman shall live, but the taxes thereon and repairs thereto are to be paid by her or made at her expense.

The land in which Susie Coleman Lagenback leased her share to Henry Coleman for his life, by the instrument recorded in Deed Book 189, Page 339 (This is the agreement being annulled by this instrument), and which, by another instrument dated as of today, is being divided in kind between the parties hereto is briefly described as follows:

A tract of land containing 98 acres, more or less, located in Bates Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, known as the Hiram Bradley Home Place and being the same as is more fully described in Item 11 of the Will of said Hiram Bradley Coleman.
