I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Claude Henson

on or about the 12th day of May in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-one exhibited his

complaint in the ~~Court of Common Pleas~~ ^{County} Court, for the County aforesaid, against
Elma E. Henson, et al.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to
be heard on the 12th day of September 1951,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Hattie Myrtle Henson Barton
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Preesents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Hattie Myrtle Henson Barton

"All that certain tract of land situate about twelve miles north of
Greer, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, near Liberty
Methodist Church and described as follows:

BEGINNING on a red oak in the old ford of the Tyger River; thence N.
29 W. 3.30 chs. to a stone; thence N. 12 W. 7.82 chs. to a stone, N. 70 W.
9.50 chs. to a stone; thence S. 10 W. 18.25 chs. to a stake on the river;
thence down the river to the beginning corner and containing 30 acres,
more or less."

This deed is made pursuant to the order of Court in the above action
and is without any monetary consideration. For that reason, it is not
necessary to place any revenue stamps on said deed.
