(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bessie Jackson, for and during the term of her natural life, with remainder to Cathryn Jackson, Walter B. Jackson, Rexell Jackson, Bessie S. Foster and Carnell Jackson, in equal proportions, their heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 8.98 acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances to-wit:

BEGINNING at point in center of Robert Chandler road thence along line of Maunch Brock S. 45-45 E. 958 feet to a point in surface treated road Pelzer to Woodville, thence along said road S. 65-30 W. 313.5 feet to angle in road, thence S. 85 W. 171 feet 5 inches to angle in road, thence N. 82 W. 413 feet to joint corner of grantor and Brock, thence along line of grantor N. 9-35 E. 685 feet 5 inches to point in Robert Chandler road; thence N. 41-15 E. 105 feet 6 inches to point of origin.
