Know All Men by These Presents:

That We, George Koury and Louise Koury Parker in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Partition of Property and Nine Hundred and No/100- - - - DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mary Koury and Sidney Koury, their Heirs and assigns,

All those lots of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northern side of Green Avenue, in the City of Greenville, and described as follows:

(1) BEGINNING at a stake on the North side of Green Avenue and running thence N. 16-30 W. 123 feet to an iron pin in Mrs. M. L. Pack's line; thence S. 71 W. 102 feet to an iron pin in Mrs. Thornburg's line; thence S. 16 E. 153 feet to a stake; thence N. 74 E. 65 feet to a stake in the Northern side of Green Avenue; thence N. 30 E. 52 feet along Green Avenue, to the beginning corner.

(2) BEGINNING at an iron pin on said Avenue, and running thence along said Avenue, N. 30-30 E. 48.5 feet to an iron pin in the middle to a 30-foot street, now abandoned; thence S. 74-15 W. along the middle of said abandoned Street, 48.5 feet to an iron pin in the continuation of the J. W. Thornburg line; thence with said line continued S. 11 E. 47 feet to the beginning.

This deed intentionally includes that portion of above property conveyed to John Thomas Koury by deed recorded in Book of Deeds 339 at Page 421 and at Page 430.

Being the same property conveyed to Thomas Koury by B. F. Hitenall by deed recorded in Volume 99 at Page 415, the said Thomas Koury died testate August 25, 1945, and by his will filed in Apartment 502, File 29, in the Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County, devised the above property to his wife and then to eight children, subsequently his wife, Virginia Koury, died on March 24, 1947, as more fully appears by her will recorded in Apartment 530 at File 15 in the Office of the Probate Judge for Greenville County, and this deed is executed in partition of the said estates.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

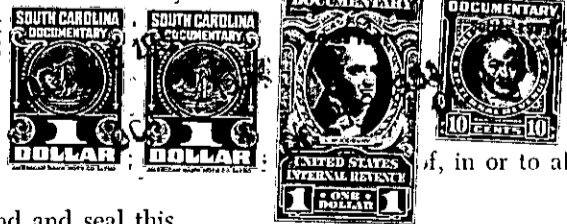
