leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said May McPhail Allen,  
her heirs and assigns forever: All our right, title and interest in and to the following  
described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State  
of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, in Ward One,  
City of Greenville, on the north side of West Stone Avenue, State and County aforesaid,  
and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Stone Avenue, about 300 feet from  
Rutherford Street, and running thence N. 1-0 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 86-  
0 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 1-0 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on Stone Avenue;
