STEVENS & CO., INC., a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, for and in consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar to it in hand paid by GREENVILLE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto,

GREENVILLE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA:

All streets, roadways, sidewalks (if any), and alleyways situate, lying, and being outside the limits of the City of Greer in the Greer Plant Village of the grantor, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, as shown on a plat entitled "Subdivision of Greer Mill Village, Greer, S. C." made by Dalton & Neves, January, 1951, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book Y, at pages 138 and 139; except -

- (1) Jennings Street from the Southern side of Hollis Street to the Southern side of Haynes Street.
- (2) Robinson Street from the Eastern side of Jennings Street to the Western side of Parker Street.
- (3) Mill Street from the Southern side of Hollis Street to the Northern side of Robinson Street.
- (4) A street indicated on said plat as "Due East" running from Jennings Street in a Westerly direction to the Eastern side of an alleyway.
