Know All Men by These Presents:

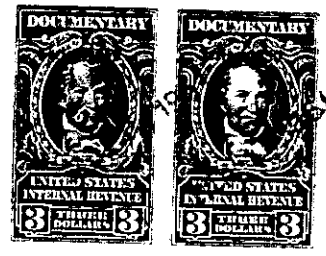
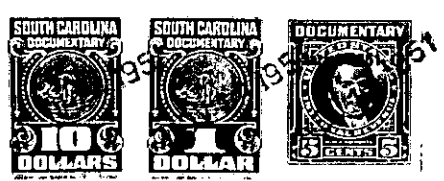

All that piece, parcel or lot of land lying, being and situate in the County and State aforesaid, Fairview Township, Town of Fountain Inn on Craig Street, with the following metes and bounds, to-wit: BEGINNING at an iron pin on said Street, being joint front corner with lot now owned by James T. Boland, formerly owned by J. O. Waddell, running thence along line of Boland S. 75 E. 197.8 feet to an iron pin on line of land formerly belonging to J. C. Drummond, now owned by Buckner, Ellen & W.
