west, and the right-of-way of the P. & N. Railway on the East, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western edge of the P. & N. Railroad right-of-way, where the same intersects with the western edge of Goodwin Street (not opened) and running thence along the western edge of Goodwin Street, N. 21-20 W. 168.5 feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence crossing Goodwin Street, N. 60-0 E. 30 feet to a point on the eastern edge of Goodwin Street; thence along the eastern edge of Goodwin Street, N. 21-30 W. 10 feet to a point on the eastern edge of said street, corner of the Norris property; thence along the line of the Norris property, N. 60-0 E. 36 feet to an iron pin on the P. & N. Railroad right-of-way; thence along said right-of-way, in a southerly direction, 200 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
