

Trustee may deem advisable.

To determine any question which may arise as to what constitutes income and principal, such determination to be conclusive.

In general, to do all things and to exercise all powers reasonably necessary or incidental to the proper management of said trust.

SEVENTH: This trust shall be known and designated as Cannon Memorial Park and Mausoleum Perpetual Upkeep Trust Fund.

EIGHTH: The Trustee shall be entitled to compensation for its services hereunder at the rate of $2\frac{1}{2}\%$ of the value of the corpus when and as received by it, together with $2\frac{1}{2}\%$ upon all income when collected by it and $2\frac{1}{2}\%$ on all income as disbursed by it.

NINTH: The Trustee is authorized in the discharge of its duties to employ counsel and agents and to determine and pay them reasonable compensation, and it shall be entitled to reimbursement therefor, and for all other expenses and charges that it may deem it necessary and proper to incur.

TENTH: The Owner shall have the right at all times by instrument in writing, executed with the same formalities as a deed to real estate, and delivered to the Trustee, to modify, alter, amend or add to any of the provisions of this indenture, provided however, such alterations, modifications, amendments or additions shall in no way change the basic purpose of said trust.

ELEVENTH: The Trustee may at any time, and shall upon written request by the Owner, submit its resignation as Trustee hereunder. Such resignation shall be made by written notice mailed by registered mail to the Owner, and by publication of a notice thereof in some newspaper published in the County of Greenville, South Carolina. Upon receipt of said notice the Owner shall, by an instrument executed in the same manner as these presents, appoint a successor Trustee, who, upon the acceptance of said trust, shall become vested with the same powers and subject to the same duties conferred on the original Trustee. Upon the resigning Trustee making a satisfactory accounting to the successor Trustee, it shall thereupon be relieved and discharged of all duties and obligations herein contained. If for any reason the Park shall fail, within thirty days after receipt of such written notice, to appoint a successor Trustee, the Trustee may apply to the Court of
