

Common Pleas for the County and State aforesaid, for an accounting and discharge, and such Court shall have authority to appoint a successor Trustee.

TWELFTH: In the event of any merger, consolidation or reorganization or reincorporation, to which The First National Bank of Greenville is a party, and by reason of which any other banking corporation organized either under the laws of the United States of America or of the State of South Carolina, shall succeed to the business and acquire the assets, or the greater portion thereof, of The First National Bank of Greenville such successor corporation shall be and become Trustee with the same force and effect and with the same duties and powers as if such successor corporation had been herein specifically nominated as such Trustee.

THIRTEENTH: The Trustee hereby accepts the trust herein created and consents to act as Trustee hereunder.
