"All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate and being on the north side of Buncombe Street in the City and County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, adjoining the lot of James Alton, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at Alton's corner on Buncombe Street, thence N. 56 E. 195 feet along Alton's west line to an iron pin; thence N. 34 W. 60 feet to a stake; thence S. 56 W. 188 feet to a point on Buncombe Street; thence with said Buncombe Street 60 feet to the beginning corner, and being identically the same lot devised to the said George M.
