Methodist Church of Greenville, S. C., their successors and assigns:


All that piece, parcel or lot of land in **Butler** Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, on the North side of a road leaving the Pelham Road
near Amick's Store and running back to McCarter's Presbyterian
Church lot and into the Pelham Road again and being the same
