This indenture entered into by and between Woodfields, Inc., a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter referred to as Woodfields, and Roy A. Farmer, hereinafter referred to as Farmer,

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, the said Farmer owns a lot or tract of land in Gantt Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, near a certain subdivision of property belonging to Woodfields, and Farmer is desirous of obtaining a water tap on the water lines in the subdivision belonging to the said Woodfields; now, therefore,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that in and for the consideration hereinafter expressed, the said Farmer does hereby agree to construct a water line, approximately 700 feet in length, along the southeastern side of Crestfield Road, which line shall extend from the existing water line in the subdivision belonging to Woodfields to the dwelling of Farmer; said line to be constructed at the sole expense and cost of the said Farmer. Woodfields does hereby agree to furnish approximately 300 feet of two-inch galvanized iron pipe to be used by Farmer in the construction of said line, and Farmer does hereby agree to furnish the remaining 400 feet of two-inch galvanized iron pipe necessary for said construction.

It is expressly understood and agreed that upon completion of the construction of said line, the same shall become the sole property of Woodfields, free and clear of lien or encumbrance; provided, however, Farmer shall have the right
