All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the southwest side of Hill Top Drive, being known and designated as Lot No. 9 as shown on plat of a subdivision for Ray E. McAlister, made by Pickell and Pickell, Engineers, dated October 16, 1948, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, Page 153, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwest side of Hill Top Drive at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9, which pin is 206 feet from the southwest corner of Tub Mountain Road and Hill Top Drive, and running thence along the southwest side of Hill Top Drive, S. 42-50 E. 156.7 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 10; thence along line of said Lot No. 10, S. 33-40 W. 151 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 71-45 W. 196 feet to an iron pin at rear joint corner of Lots 5, 6 and 9; thence along rear line of Lots Nos. 6 and 8, N. 42-18 E. 242.3 feet to the beginning corner.
