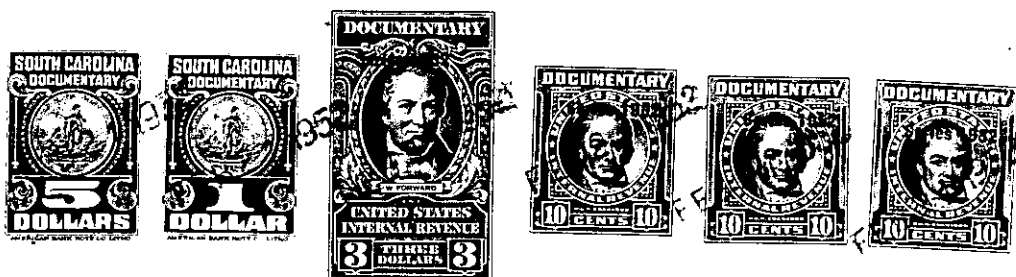

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That we, Ethel Mae Forrester and
Milford Augustus Forrester,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

Two Thousand Six Hundred and Seventy-three (\$2,673.00) Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Dorothy D. Howard

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Dorothy D. Howard, her heirs, and
assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being about six miles from the Greenville
County Court House, and about one mile north of the Town of Mauldin,
located just west of the Greenville-Laurens Highway, and on the
north side of Knollwood Drive, having the following metes and bounds,
according to a plat by J. Mack Richardson, dated August 1951:
