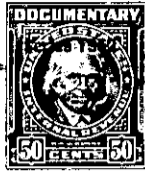

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville
 County, State of South Carolina, known as Lot No. 81 of a sub-division for
 Ray E. McAlister, Travelers Rest, South Carolina, a plat of which
 was made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, dated October 16, 1948, and
 revised February 24, 1949 and January 21, 1952, and recorded in the
