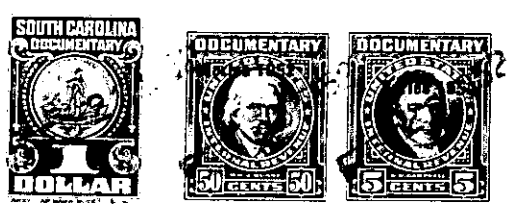

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina in Travelers Rest, and being known and designated as Lot Number Twentey Eight (No. 28) on a plat of survey of the subdivision of the property of G. W. Bridwell by T. T. Dill March 1946 recorded in R. M. C. office in Plat Book M. Page 129.

The said lot has a frontage of Fifty (50) feet on the northern side of First Street, with rear line of Fifty (50) feet, and having side lines of One Hundred Fifty (150) feet each. This property is a part of a tract of Thirty One (31) acres, more or less, conveyed to G. W. Bridwell by Jos. D. Cooper by deed recorded in Vol. 289 at page 126 in the R. M.
