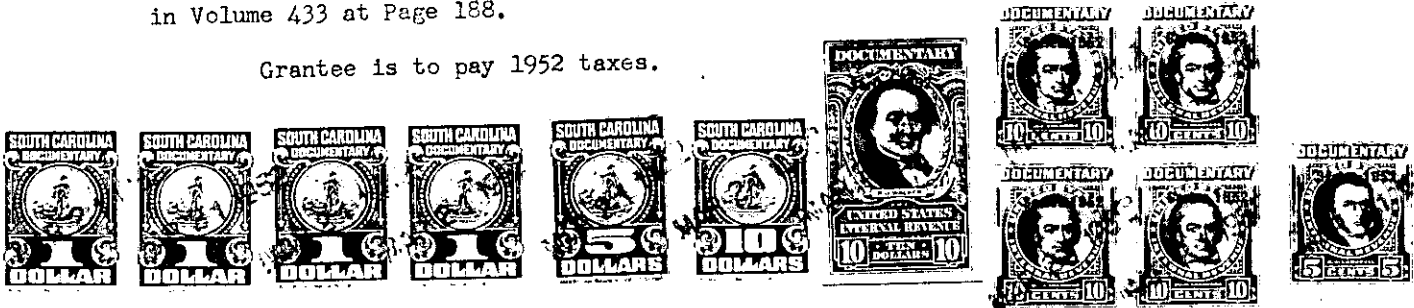

All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lot No. 132 as shown on plat of Isaqueena Park, recorded in Plat Book P at Page 130, and according to a more recent survey prepared by R. W. Dalton is described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Kirkwood Lane, joint corner of lots 131 and 132, and running thence with joint line of said lots, S. 44-06 W. 175.8 feet to an iron pin in rear line of lot 120; thence with rear line of lots 120 and 119, N. 50-35 W. 50.8 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with line of lot 119, N. 37-19 W. 18.4 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of lot 133; thence with line of said lot, N. 44-15 E. 166.7 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of Kirkwood Lane; thence with said Lane, S. 64-27 E. 34 feet to iron pin; thence continuing with said Lane, S. 45-54 E. 36 feet to the point of beginning.
