The Church of God which he hath purchased with his own blood, its headquarters the place of its location is Greenville, S. C. which has been organized of a quorum. Being two or more of the officers or agents appointed to supervise or manage the affair of The Church of God which he hath purchased with his own blood. J. F. Holcomb is General Overseer and head trustee for life and C. M. Green is Deacon and Trustee and Laybell Holcomb, General Clerk for the purposes of the aforesaid laws set forth do affirm and declare that at a meeting of the aforesaid organization held to the by laws or regulations of the aforesaid organization that the said organization holds or desires to hold property in common for a religious educational charitable or other eleemosynary purpose or any two or more of said purposes and is not organized for the purpose of profit or gain to the members otherwise than as above stated or for the insurance of life, health, accident or property, and that three (3) days notice in the Greenville News paper, County of Greenville, has been given that the aforesaid declaration would be filed. The said declarants and petitioners further declare and affirm first their names and residences are as above given, second the name of the proposed quorum is The Church of God which he hath purchased with his own blood. The third, the place at which it purposes to have its headquarters or to be located is Greenville, S. C. fourth, the purpose of the said proposed quorum is The Church of God which he hath purchased with his own blood, stands for the whole Bible. fifth, the names and residences of all managers, trustees, directors or other officers are as follows: J. F. Holcomb, General Overseer and head trustee for life, Bleachery Road, Route No. 3, C. M. Green, Deacon and trustee, 14 Bailey St., Laybell Holcomb, General Clerk, all of Greenville, S. C. This is the by laws in the church:

That the property cannot be sold except the signature of the General Overseer, J. F. Holcombe, which is the head trustee and all the property when bought or given, must be deeded to the Church of God which he hath purchased with his own blood, headquarters at Greenville, S. C. and no staff of Bishop can be set up no where in the world to take the property away from The Church or against the general overseer, J. F. Holcomb, and no organization can take this property under a quorum or a chart of any state or in the world. And the general overseer, J. F. Holcomb, has the power to appoint and ordain bishops and the church has a right to appoint and commission bishops and evangelists and deacons and no church has no right to ordain any of them they sent to the general overseer for their ordain papers, and the bishop ordains them. And also the general overseer has the power to appoint the states overseers to each state as it suits him. And all the ministers of the church is to cooperate with their stateoverseers and all of the ministers of the church is to cooperate with their stateoverseer and all of the ministers and stateoverseers in all the world is to cooperate with their generaloverseer, J. F. Holcomb. And no stateoverseer or minister has no power to set up a board of bishops against the church or the generaloverseer, J. F. Holcomb anywhere in the world and if any one of the ministers or bishops are not loyal to the doctrine of the bible or any of the bylaws of the church, their papers will be revoked by the generaloverseer and no stateoverseer has no power to revoke none of the ministers or bishop papers without the permission from the generaloverseer. And the generaloverseer has the power to revoke bishop's papers and evangelist's papers and deacon's papers at any time they fail to cooperate with the generaloverseer. Any stateoverseer that he shall appoint to any state or county and they begin to work against the church or attempts to perform a board of bishop against the church or the generaloverseer he has the power to revoke his papers and take all of his position and the church will disfellowship them and all that take sides with them on the charge of destroying and sowing discord. The generaloverseer has the power to carry on the business for the Church of God which he hath purchased with his own blood anywhere or any state where ever he likes. There is no compelling power to keep the generaloverseer at headquarters. The generaloverseer has the power to carry on the business for the headquarter where ever he might be and manage and supervise all the affair of the church and no general assembly or no group of people in any state shall not change this of the general
