All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate on the northeast side of LeGrand Boulevard in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot 21 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August 1951, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "BB", Pages 30 and 31, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of LeGrand Boulevard at joint front corner of Lots 20 and 21, and running thence along the line of Lot 20, N. 40-49 E. 160 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 49-11 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 22, S. 40-49 W. 160 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of LeGrand Boulevard; thence with the northeast side of LeGrand Boulevard, S. 49-11 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
