in consideration of the sum of FIVE HUNDRED NO/100 DOLLARS,

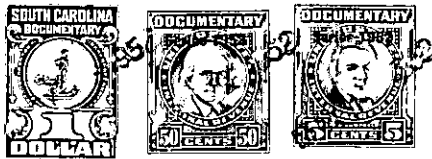

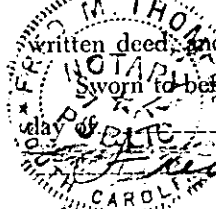

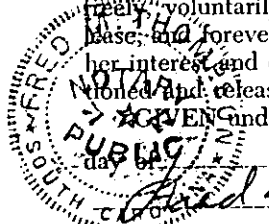
