(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **C. J. Smith, Sr., his Heirs and**

**Assigns forever:**

**My whole and entire undivided/interest in and to -**

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in **Fairview** Township, **Greenville**

County, State of South Carolina **and in the town of Fountain Inn on the west side of Weston Street with the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron fence post, corner with Mrs. Irene B. Humphries and on line of lot of Mrs. Kate Woods and running thence S. 32 E. approximately 74.25 feet to a point, joint corner with lot of C. J. Smith, Jr.; thence with line of lot of C. J. Smith, Jr., approximately 112 feet to a point on Weston Street, joint front corner with lot of said C. J. Smith, Jr.; thence with Weston Street N. 36 3/4 W/ approximately 82.8 feet to a point, joint front corner with lot of Mrs. Irene B.
