All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, and being a part of Tract No. 2 of the S. L. Jones Estate as shown on plat made by W. A. Hester, January 24, 1929 and recorded in Plat Book "G", at page 233 and having the following metes and bounds, according to said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin on a road leading from the old Rutherford Road to the Paris Mountain Reservoir and running thence, S. 9 W. 13.55 chains to a stake in old ford in branch; thence with the branch as the line in a northeasterly direction to the road above referred to; thence with said road as a line in a northwesterly direction to the beginning corner, and containing, by estimation, eight (8) acres, more or less.

Being the same tract of land conveyed to our father, John S. Hall, and our mother, Amy G. Hall, the grantee herein, by Mattie F. Jenkins by deed dated November 18, 1930 and of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 157, page 376. The said John S. Hall departed this life intestate on the 7th day of March, 1952 leaving as his sole heirs at law, the grantors and the grantee herein, all of whom are sui juris.
