in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and re-  
leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. L. Hallman

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in \_\_\_\_\_ Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina,

ALL That piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in  
Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,  
described as follows:

BEGINNING At a sweetgum on a branch the northern corner of the tract of  
land sold by John C. Fisher and wife to Ola D. Campbell by deed dated  
December 20, 1937, recorded in Book 201, Page 443, Greenville County  
Register, said sweetgum being also in the Pennell line, and running  
thence with the Pennell line, N. 15<sup>o</sup>-50' W. 507 feet to a stone Pennell's  
corner, thence still with the Pennell line S. 56-55 W. 1148 feet to a  
stone; thence still with Pennell's line, S. 4-30 W. 452 feet to a stake  
in Vaughn's Creek, thence with said creek three calls as follows: S.  
43 E. 59 feet; S. 46 E. 208 feet; S. 5 W. 66 feet to a stake in said  
creek the northwest corner of the tract of land now owned by Ola D.  
Campbell, which was sold by John C. Fisher to Pinckney D. Campbell by  
deed dated November 30, 1934, recorded in Deed Book 178, Page 276,  
Greenville County Register, thence with said Ola D. Campbell's line as  
follows: N. 35 E. 326 feet to a stone the western corner of the tract  
sold by John C. Fisher to Ola D. Campbell December 20, 1937; thence  
still with Campbell's line and to the beginning the following calls:  
N. 38-30 E. 255 feet; N. 61 E. 200 feet to a stone and pointers in the  
branch; N. 26-30 E. 300 feet to a stone and pointers in the branch; N.  
85 E. 200 feet; N. 57 E. 100 feet to the sweetgum tree which is the be-  
ginning corner. The said tract conveying 15-1/3 acres, more or less.  
Being the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed of John C.  
Fisher, recorded in Deed Book 203, Page 27 on April 14, 1938.
