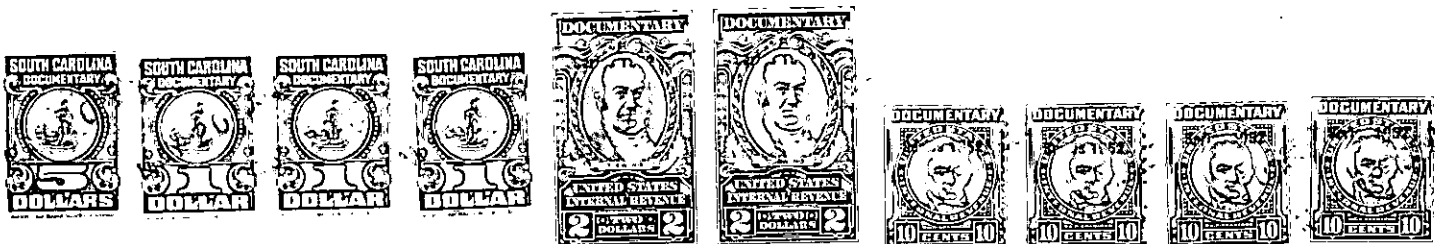
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James W. Bagwell, his Heirs and Assigns forever,

All that lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 42 on Plat of the property of Albert Q. Taylor, made by Dalton & Neves in May, 1946, recorded in Plat Book P at Page 49, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of East Gantt Street, at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 41 and 42, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 41, S. 40-15 W. 166.3 feet to iron pin at rear corner of Lot No. 32; thence with the rear line of Lot No. 32, N. 53-42 W. 100.3 feet to iron pin at rear corner of Lot No. 43; thence with the line of Lot No. 43, N. 40-15 E. 175 feet to iron pin on East Gantt Street; thence with the Southwestern side of East Gantt Street, S. 48-44 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

Said premises being a portion of the same conveyed to the Grantor by deed recorded in Book of Deeds 293 at Page 367.
