All that certain triangular section of lot No. 1 in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, as shown on plat of the property of J. P. Owings, recorded in Plat Book X at Page 36, lying north of S. C. Highway No. 123, and being described by metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Highway No. 123, and running thence N. 25-30 W. 45.1 feet to point on old road; thence with said road, in a southwesterly direction 69 feet to pin on right-of-way of S. C. Highway No. 123; thence with the Northern side of said right-of-way, S. 85-20 E. 68 feet to the point of beginning.
