Know All Men by These Presents:

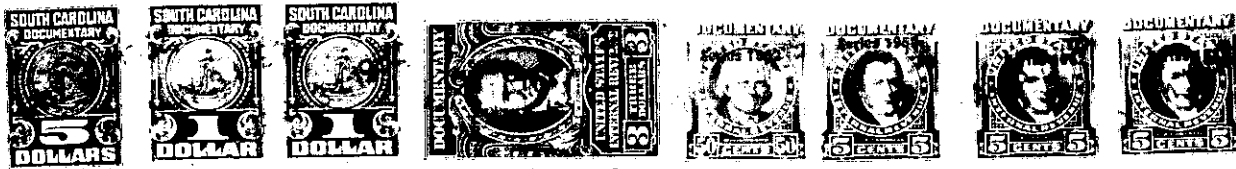
That I, Homer Styles, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Thirty-two hundred forty-two and 00/100 DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Roy Walters, his heirs and assigns, all that certain lot or lot of land, with buildings and improvements, and being in Bates Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, at Travelers Rest, S. C., being known and designated as Lot No. 32 on a subdivision for Roy E. McAlister, which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, according to said plat, the following being the description:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of McAlister Street at the joint front corner of Lot No. 32, running thence S. 41-40 W. 252 feet to an iron pin at Lot No. 33; thence S. 43-48 E. 100.00 feet to an iron pin at Lot No. 32; thence N. 41-40 E. 252.00 feet to an iron pin at the corner of McAlister Street; thence with McAlister Street N. 49-27 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

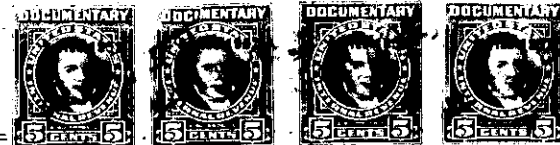
