That I, C. P. Holland in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and No/100- (\$400.00) DOLLARS,

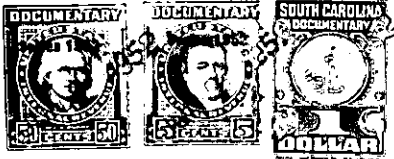
to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Roy Browning, his Heirs and assigns forever,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the South-east side of River Drive, at River Falls, in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 11 on Plat of Cool River Heights, made by J. C. Hill, Surveyor, September 2, 1947, recorded in Plat Book 3 at Page 5, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of River Drive, joint front corner of Lots 10 and 11, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 10, S. 52-45 E. 225 feet to an iron pin in the center of Gap Creek; thence up Gap Creek in a Northeasterly direction 110 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in the center of Gap Creek, at rear corner of Lot No. 12; thence with the line of Lot No. 12, N. 52-45 W. 257 feet to an iron pin in the center of River Drive; thence with the center of River Drive, S. 34 W. 97 feet to the beginning corner.

Said premises being the same conveyed to the Grantor by deed recorded in Book of Deeds 347 at Page 99.
