The same procedure shall be had with regard to each of the grantor's grandchildren. At the present time the said C. F. Putman has five grandchildren, namely: Tommie Jones, Gerald Claude Jones, Harriett Lee Baumgardner, Claude Farrow Lewis and Dodge Lewis. This trust is set up for their equal benefit and the equal benefit of any other grandchild which the grantor may have, for the purpose of providing said grandchildren with a college education if they so desire and, if not, to provide them with a fund in money at their twenty-first (21st) birthday.

(6) The Trustee shall be allowed commissions of five per cent (5%) of all income received by him from the investment of these trust funds.

It is recognized that the Trustee will need the services of legal counsel in connection with this trust and it is my desire that he use the services of J. D. Todd, Jr., the attorney who prepared this instrument.

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said H. L. Baumgardner, as Trustee, his successors and assigns, against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
