CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, ROY M. GULLICK AND J. M. WOODS

both of Greenville, S. C.

did on the 5th. day of September, 19 51 file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is STYLE-CHAPTERS, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is a general brokerage, manufacturing, merchantile, and warehousing business for the purpose of handling and producing all types of products and property, and dealing with the same in any manner; with the right to acquire, lease, own, sell and mortgage real and personal property; to advance or obtain credit, and to invest in securities or other businesses; to enter into contracts, and to acquire trademarks, patents and the like; to do any acts incident to and in furtherance of said business, and to exercise all general powers necessary or advisable in connection with accomplishings the purposes of the corporation in the State of South Carolina and elsewhere.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Forty Thousand (\$40,000.00) - - - - -Dollars payable in cash or merchandise at the call of the directors.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is 3,000 preferred of the par value of \$10.00 of the par value of per share and 10,000 common of the par value of \$1.00 per share

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 1st. day of September, 19 51, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

Roy M. Gullick and J. M. Woods

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Roy M. Gullick ;
as Vice-President, J. M. Woods ; as Secretary, Roy M. Gullick ;
as Treasurer, J. M. Woods

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1942, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville News a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
