

4. Only sanitary sewage shall be delivered to the Greater Greenville Sewer District trunk line at Richland Creek and no water from storm sewers or air conditioning units shall be transported to the aforementioned trunk line or accepted by the Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission.

5. As a part of the consideration herein, the Catalina Restaurants, Inc. agrees to seek immediate annexation to the City of Greenville and to the Greater Greenville Sewer District and agrees that it will use every effort at its disposal to see that the annexation is promptly effective. Upon such annexation becoming an accomplished fact, this contract shall come to a close.

6. The construction and maintenance of any lines necessary to deliver the sanitary sewage to the aforementioned trunk line of the Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission shall be the sole responsibility of Catalina Restaurants, Inc. and the Catalina Restaurants, Inc. shall be responsible for any damages ensuing to any one as a result of said construction and maintenance and, further, any and all such construction shall be in accordance with specifications of the Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission.

7. The privileges extended to the Catalina Restaurants, Inc. under this agreement shall apply to it and it alone and not to any tenants of Catalina Restaurants, Inc. and connections for no other property except that presently owned by the Catalina Restaurants, Inc. shall be allowed.

8. The charges set forth above for handling this sewage is subject to change, depending upon the costs involved to the Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission and Catalina Restaurants, Inc. agrees that it will pay whatever charge the Greater Greenville Sewer District Commission imposes, based upon such costs.
