That I, Frank Stephens, in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 (1.00) and love and affection, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ola Stephens Harris, her heirs and assigns, forever

All of my undivided one-half interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina bordering on the North side of Pelham Road, about eight miles from the City of Greenville and near Rocky Creek Church, containing 2.41 acres more or less and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the middle of Pelham Road approximately 855.1 feet Westerly from the intersection of said Pelham Road with a County Road leading to Woodruff, S. C., thence N.19-W. 97 feet to an iron pin; thence N.22-W. 145 feet to an iron pin; thence N.46-W. 141 feet to an iron pin; thence N.78-W. 93 feet to an iron pin; thence S.88-10 W. 126 feet to an iron pin; thence S.7-15E. 390.2 feet to an iron pin in the middle of Pelham Road; thence along said Pelham Road N. 81-45 E. 342 feet to the point of beginning.
