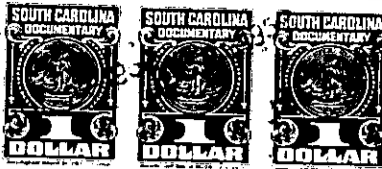

Know All Men, by These Presents:

That We, L. A. Moseley and John T. Douglas in consideration of the sum of One Thousand, Seventy-Five and 50/100 (\$1075.50) DOLLARS.

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William Howard Smith, his heirs and assigns, forever.

All that lot of land situate on the west side of Robin Hood Road, in the City of Greenville, Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 151 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Heves, Engineers, August 1951, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "E", Pages 50 and 51, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of Robin Hood Road at point front corner of Lots 150 and 151 and running thence along the line of said lots, N. 100.4 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 14-50 E. 78.20 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 152, S. 31-58 E. 154.3 feet to an iron pin at the west side of Robin Hood Road; thence along the west side of Robin Hood Road, S. 3-30 W. 75 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed subject to restrictions which are of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 457, Page 177.
