in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bobby Ray Littlejohn, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the North side of Gordan Street in Judson Mills No. 2 Village, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 9 of Block D as shown on a plat of Judson Mills No. 2 Village made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in March, 1939, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book K at pages 1 and 2, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Gordan Street at joint front corner of Lots 8 and 9 of Block D, and running thence with line of Lot 8, N. 18-47 W. 114.2 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of Lot 12, N. 53-51 E. 55.6 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of Lot 10, S. 18-47 E. 130.8 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Gordan Street; thence with the North side of Gordan Street, S. 71-13 W. 53 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to us by B. Graydon Mullinax by his deed dated April 27th, 1944 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 263, at page 121.

The above described lot is shown on the Township Tax Map at Sheet 116, Block 14, Lot 8, and the grantee is to pay taxes for the year 1952, said taxes having been pro-rated as of this date.
