TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises aforementioned unto the said R. D. and Lottie Joner, their heirs and assigns forever, together with the appurtenances thereunto or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all of the right, title, interest and claim what-soever thereto belonging or to be held by the South Carolina State Highway Department.

In accepting this instrument, however, the grantees agree that they will take such measures as shall be necessary to protect the drainage of the highway bed at this location, and that should any damage result from interference with the drainage of the highway bed, or adjacent properties, the grantees will save harmless and indemnify the South Carolina State Highway Department from any such loss or damage, or any liability resulting therefrom.
